Dear Conor,


It was great to meet you yesterday. Thank you once again for your support for Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF).

The funds you raised, totalling €15,333.28, will go towards MSF's work in Syria and the Mediterranean. Last year, MSF's Search and Rescue operations assisted almost 24,000 people from Syria and other countries who were trying to reach the safety of Europe. This work is continuing in 2016 with three vessels, the Aquarius, Bourbon Argos and Dignity I, currently in the Mediterranean. Just yesterday, more than 200 people were rescued by the Aquarius and Dignity I.
